



**VISUAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS 2011**

The Edmonds Arts Festival Foundation (EAFF) annually provides up to \$20,000.00 in post secondary education visual arts scholarships to students living within the boundaries of the Edmonds School District.

**The Award** EAFF offers annual tuition grants up to \$2,500 each. All scholarships are in the form of certificates of award, conditional upon acceptance of the student to an accredited art school, college, or university. EAFF will send a check for the amount of the award to the recipient's school for credit to the student's account.

**Eligibility** Any resident, age 17 or older, who is a graduating high school senior or a graduate from any previous year, and has a permanent address within the boundaries of the Edmonds School District is eligible to apply. Applicant must be pursuing full time post secondary education in the visual arts at an accredited art school, college or university in the next academic school year and must have graduated from high school by August 2011.

**Selection Process** The EAFF Scholarship Committee, using established evaluation criteria, will select students based on a review of applications, individual interviews, and portfolio presentations. Scholarships are subjective and awarded at the sole discretion of the EAFF. Applications may be refused for any reason.

**Application Requirements**

1. A completed Edmonds Arts Festival Foundation scholarship form.
2. An official copy of current school transcript.
3. A letter of scholastic and artistic intent.
4. Three letters of reference from persons other than relatives, one reference must be from an art teacher.
5. A portfolio of student's art work (maximum of 10 pieces) to be presented at an interview.
6. Mandatory interview on April 15 between 1pm and 5pm is necessary to qualify for a scholarship. Interview will be at ArtWorks, 201 Second Ave S, Edmonds
7. Scholarship recipients are required to volunteer 3 hours at the 2011 Edmonds Arts Festival. Volunteer opportunities begin June 10 and continue through June 20.

**Deadline**

**Applications must be received in our office by postal mail no later than Thursday, March 31, 2011.**

**No applications will be accepted after this date. No FAX or EMAIL applications will be accepted.**

**Renewal** Once a student has been selected in the scholarship process, renewal of funding is possible on an annual basis. The EAFF should be advised by Feb 15, 2011 with a request for an application. A renewal application will be sent. **Renewals do not require interview.**

**The following criteria must be met for renewal consideration of the EAFF Scholarship:**

1. **Full-time student status** in an accredited art school, college, or university.
2. Satisfactory progress toward a college **degree in art**.
3. Official school transcripts of work completed and in process toward your degree.
4. One letter of reference from a college level art instructor.
5. 7–10 samples of your current artwork (presented in any format – photographs, Windows format CD, photocopies, etc.)
6. The completed EAFF Arts Scholarship Renewal form.
7. Scholarship recipients are required to volunteer 3 hours at the 2011 Edmonds Arts Festival.  
Volunteer opportunities begin June 10 and continue through June 20.

  7. Scholarship recipients are required to volunteer 3 hours at the 2011 Edmonds Arts Festival.
